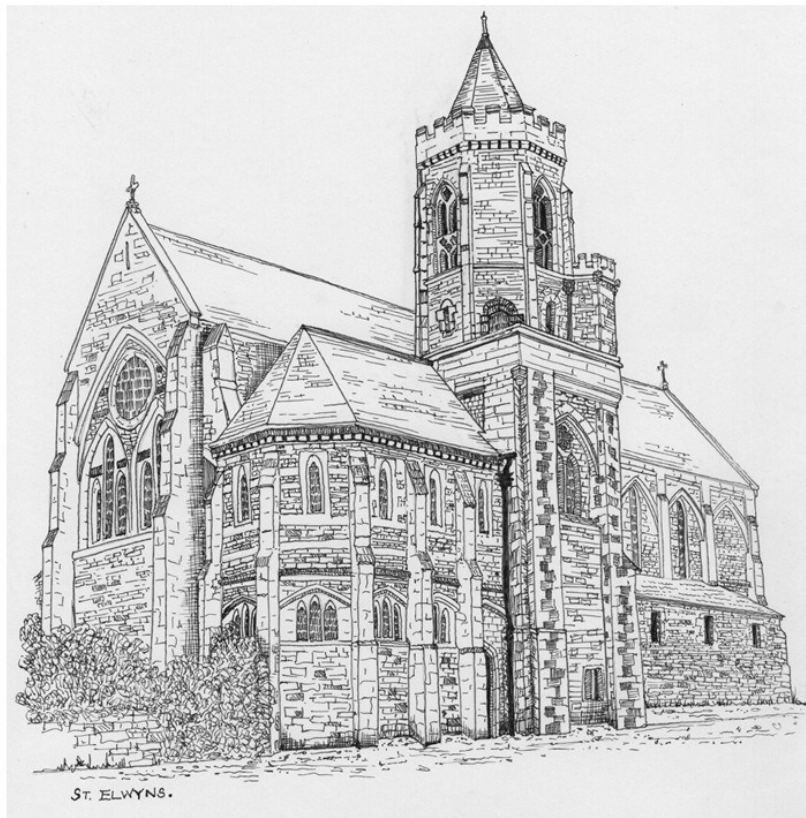

Dear Friends

Chairman's letter

India has been in our news: the Test cricket series completed last Monday delivered nerve-racking excitement and a draw that was creditable to both India and England; the government have signed our own British trade agreement with India; and lastly and less happily, the trade sanctions imposed on India by the US administration. Less dramatically but of huge importance is the advance of the monsoon during the summer period in India, which this year looks like being 'above average'. The monsoon matters to everyone: as the Government of India Press Information Bureau makes clear,

'The monsoon is more than just a season of rain for India. This unique and powerful climate system is a lifeline for the people of the country, with wide ranging, direct and indirect effects on its socio-economic fabric. Monsoon rains are critical for the agricultural sector with productivity and food grain prices closely linked to a good monsoon. They are crucial for replenishing the country's water reserves, and for generation of hydro-electricity.'

So this is welcome news, and also that children have returned to schools in Delhi after the intense heat of the pre-monsoon summer break.

The Coffee Morning and Sale in May held by Trustees—with many helpers—was a successful event, raising almost £2500. We are also pleased to report that we have submitted our Trustees Annual Report and Accounts to our regulator the Charity Commission, which is available on their website, and which is also attached to this letter for your information and convenience.

Even more, we are delighted that Father Monodeep of the Delhi Brotherhood Society will visit us from Delhi in September, staying in Wye for the long weekend of 19–22 September. Any supporters interested in meeting Monodeep will be welcome at the 10.00am service at Wye Parish Church on Sunday 21 September.
